HOMEWATCH GROUP GUIDELINES



Neighbourhood groups are a great way to build safer, stronger and more resilient communities

These guidelines are based on the policies adopted by the

Neighbourhood Watch Network. They will help ensure you don't accidentally go against any legislation.

Fairness, respect and courtesy:

- Treat your members (and anyone else) fairly and with respect
- Don't discriminate against anybody regardless of their race, sex, religion or any other characteristic they may possess
- Try and be inclusive to all sectors of the local community

Responsibilities and accountability:

- Be aware of the points of view of all members
- Keep an eye on what is being said / done in the group and challenge inappropriate behaviour
- Keep members informed if you make decisions which affect the group
- Think about the impact on the local community of any actions taken / views expressed by your group

Confidentiality:

- Respect other people's privacy
- Take care how you store (and use) personal data. Don't pass on contact details without the permission of the individual concerned

Conduct:

• Don't behave in a way which would bring discredit to your own group or the groups of others.

Honesty:

- Keep records if your group deals with any money
- Watch out for conflicts of interest
